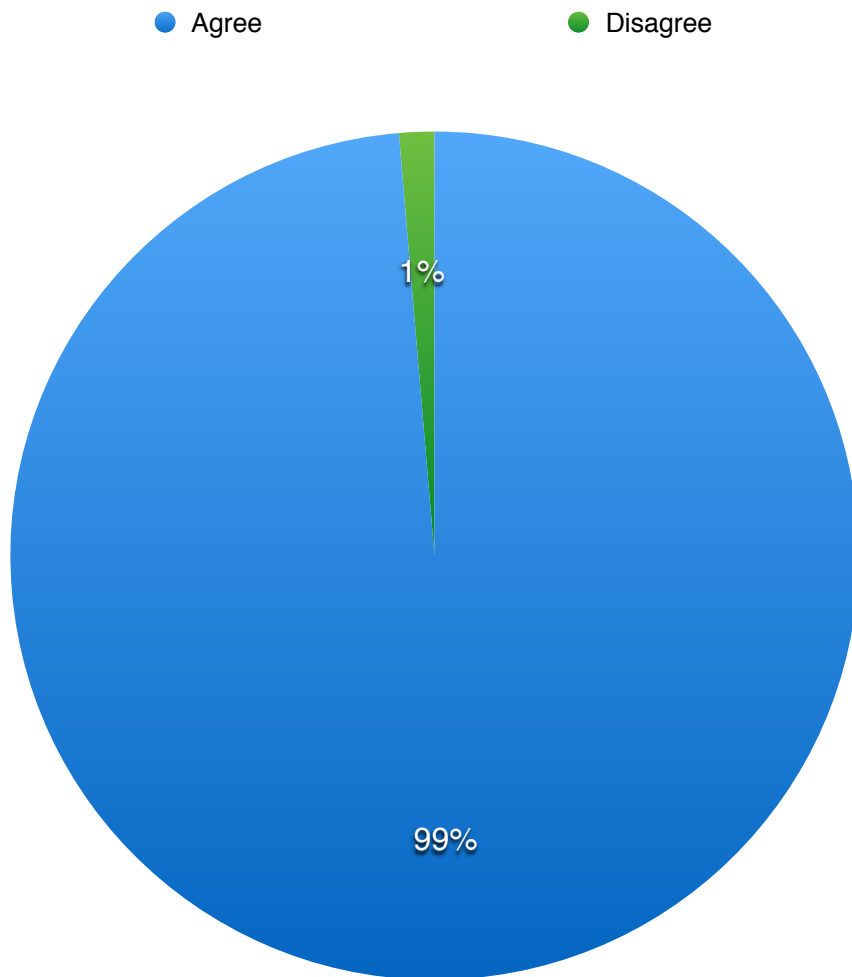


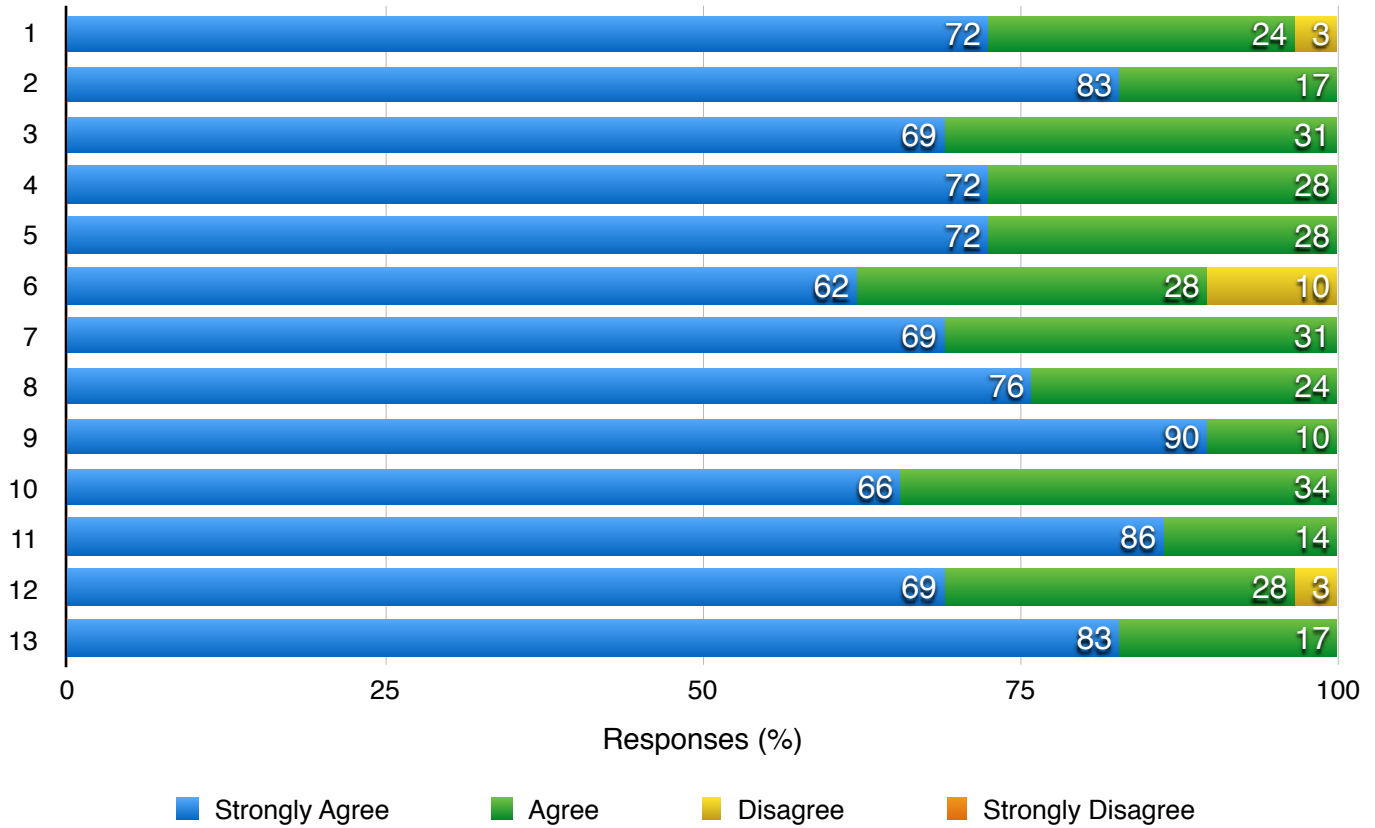
Parent Survey September 2016

There were 29 completed surveys submitted with 13 questions. This returned 377 responses. The analysis can be found below.
