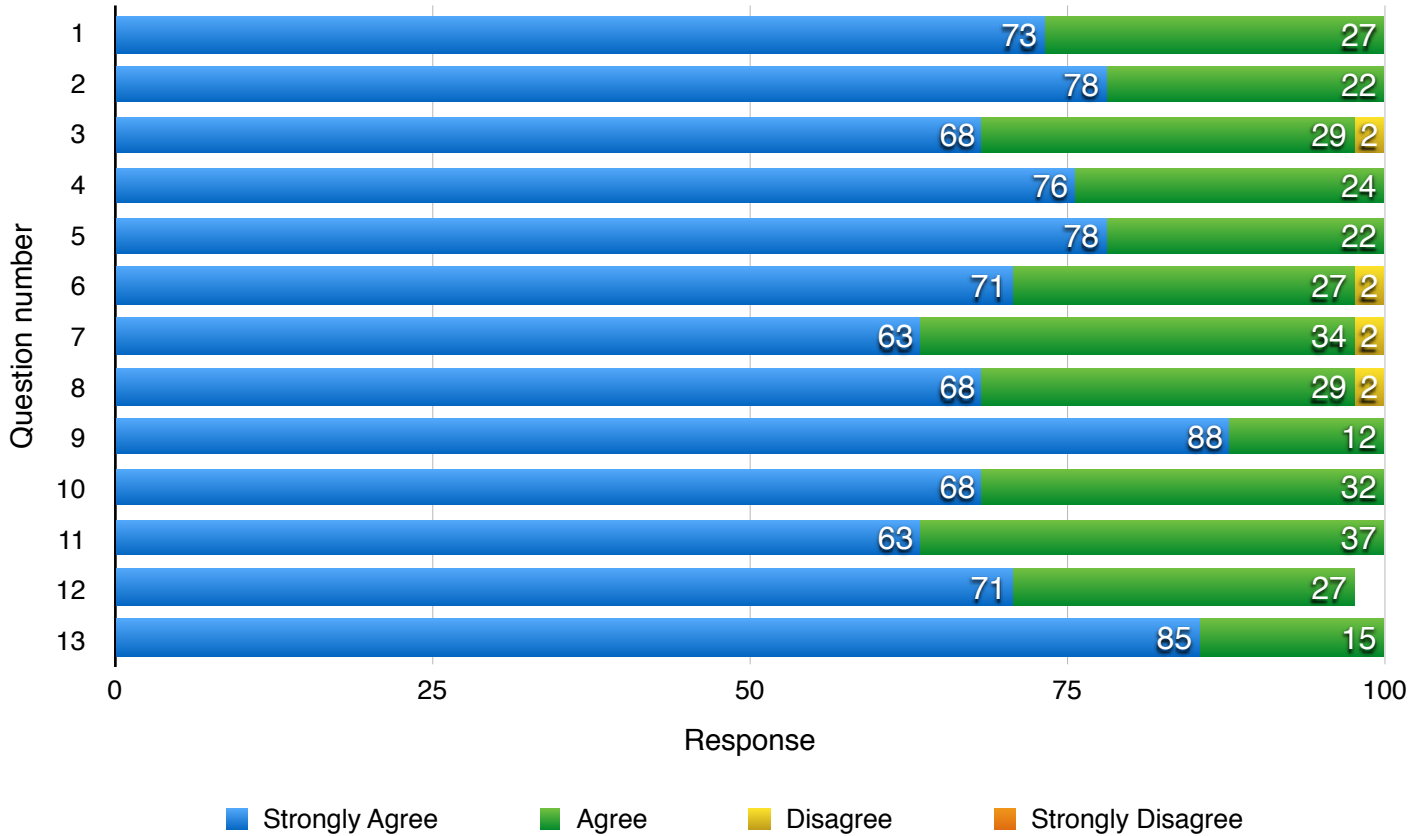


Parent Survey June 2017

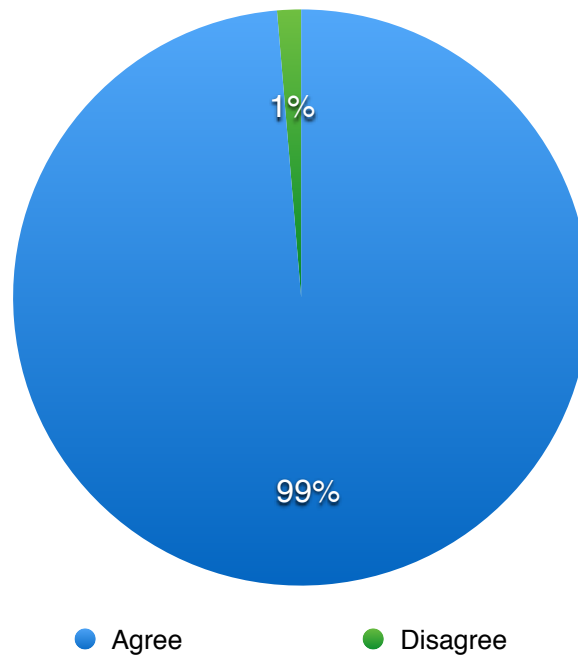
The survey was conducted at the Parent-Teacher consultation event, June 2017. The outcome will be used to inform School Improvement Planning. There were 41 completed surveys submitted with 13 questions. This returned 533 responses. The analysis can be found below. Question Level Analysis
