- Our new playground equipment

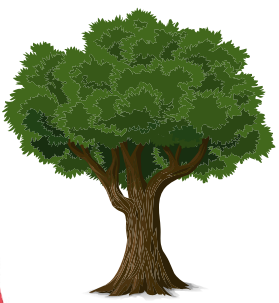
We have lots of exciting events and activities planned for the coming year to help raise money for our small school and ensure our children have fun along the way!
