

We welcomed Miss Benbow on Tuesday to discuss the story of the Road to Emmaus.


Please make sure your child has their PE kit in every day as these days may change at short notice and we may need to go outside for other areas of the curriculum.

We're around every Friday in term time 9.30-11am in the school hall. Everyone is welcome, £2.50 per family.


